**ABDOMINAL CANINE**

**OBSERVATIONS**

**Abdominal remarks** A large heterogenous right adrenal mass was present distorting normal architecture and extending into and partially occluding the vena cava. There was free anechoic fluid in the retroperitoneal space consistent with haemorrhage and associated steatitis.

The liver had multifocal hypoechoic intraparenchymal nodules. The sublumbar lymph nodes were mildly enlarged. The remainder of the examination was unremarkable.

**Conclusions** Right adrenal mass consistent with pheochromoytoma invading and rupturing vena cava. Liver nodules may represent metastases or nodular hyperplasia. Prognosis grave.
