**ABDOMINAL FELINE
OBSERVATIONS**

Abdominal remarks The liver is a normal size with increased echogenicity and increased portal markings, thickened gallbladder wall, normal common bile duct. The spleen is normal. The gastrointestinal tract has normal thickness and wall layering with increased gas within tract. The pancreas is largely normal with mildly increased echogenicity of right limb. Mildly increased mesenteric lymph node. The kidneys and bladder are normal. No free abdominal fluid.

Conclusions Liver changes consistent with cholangiohepatitis. Previous episode of pancreatitis likely, no active inflammation. Mildly reactive lymph node and excess intestinal gas consistent with gastrointestinal disease. Suppurative cholangitis most likely - supportive treatment includes antibiotics, SAMe, UDCA, GI diet.
